

WIZ AUDIT HISTORY TERMS

These Wiz Audit History Terms (the "Audit History Terms") supplement and form part of the Wiz Service Specific Terms which are incorporated into the Wiz Subscription Agreement or other agreement entered into for Wiz services (the "Agreement") by and between Wiz and Customer (each as defined in the Agreement) and apply to Customer's use of the Audit History Services as further described in the Documentation (the "Audit History Services"). For the avoidance of doubt, the Audit History Services are part of the Wiz Services (or other similar term) described in the Agreement. Capitalized terms not defined in these Audit History Terms have the meanings given to them in the Agreement. In the event of any conflict between these Audit History Terms and the Agreement, these Audit History Terms will control with respect to the Audit History Services.

1. AUDIT HISTORY SERVICES. If Customer has purchased Audit History Services, the following shall apply:

- a. Customer's Audit History will be stored on a going-forward basis starting from the date Customer enables the Audit History Services and selects a retention period through the Platform.
- b. The Audit History Services, including access to any previously saved versions, are conditional on Customer having an active subscription to the Wiz Platform. All Audit History will be deleted upon expiration or termination of such subscription in accordance with the Documentation.
- c. WIZ DOES NOT WARRANT THAT THE AUDIT HISTORY SERVICES WILL MEET CUSTOMER'S REQUIREMENTS, OR THAT THEY WILL OPERATE ERROR-FREE OR WITHOUT BUGS.

2. MISCELLANEOUS.

- a. These Audit History Terms will survive termination of the Agreement.
- b. Wiz may update these Audit History Terms, and such updates will be made available at www.wiz.io/legal/legal-hub (or any successor page(s)). Except for any updates required to comply with applicable law, which shall become effective immediately, any other updates to these Audit History Terms shall become effective for Customer upon the renewal of Customer's then-current Subscription Term or upon the effective date of a new Order entered into by Customer.
- c. The representative signing or accepting these Audit History Terms represents that it has the authority to bind its organization to these Audit History Terms.
